



Georgia Pathways Quick Reference Guide

To maintain eligibility, you must prove that you are doing at least **80 hours** of qualifying activities per month. Qualifying activities include:

- Full-time or part-time employment
- On-the-job training
- Job readiness assistance programs
- Community service
- Vocational educational training
- Enrollment in the Vocational Rehabilitation program of the Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Agency (GVRA)
- Higher education
