

We go beyond the basics. Peach State Health Plan is proud to provide these extra benefits to our members. They are at no cost to you.

- Grocery Allowance* Provides qualified members age 18 and over with a grocery allowance of \$50 per quarter. Members must complete three (3) Healthy Rewards activities to qualify. Members who select this benefit will be ineligible to receive the Home Delivery Groceries.
- Walmart Grocery Delivery* Provides qualified members a 12-month benefit for members to receive healthy foods delivered directly to their home. Members must complete three (3) Healthy Rewards activities to qualify. Members who select this benefit will be ineligible to receive the Grocery Allowance.
- Housing Allowance* Members receive a \$250 annual allowance to assist with housing and utility assistance.
- Internet Access Members in grades K-12 may be eligible to receive an internet hotspot to help with virtual access to school activities. Plan would pay for up to three (3) months of internet access.
- Tutoring For qualified members in grades 3rd to 12th (ages 8 to 18), offer tutoring services to address academic barriers. Provides 10 tutoring sessions per year (maximum 1 hour per session) for members.
- Weight Watchers® *- Offers a six (6) month membership benefit for Medicaid members. The goal of the program is to support healthy lifestyles and improve health outcomes.
- Reading Scholarships Reading scholarship benefit for members in grades K-12 who want to improve their reading skills. Space is limited.
- Adult Dental Members age 21 and over Provides for members age 21 and over, no co-pay.
 - FREE oral exams and cleanings every six (6) months.
 - FREE annual bitewing X-ray for members.
 - FREE simple tooth removals for members.
 - There may be additional benefits for children 21 and under and pregnant members.
- Electric Toothbrush Eligible Peach State
 Health Plan members can receive a free electric toothbrush.

- Adult Vision Members age 21 and over Provides for members age 21 and over, no co-pay.
 - Free eye exam: one per year.
 - \$100 to annual allowance toward glasses for members age 21 and over. Members can choose glasses outside of what is covered by Medicaid.
 - Adults would have the option to receive one (1) of the following four (4) upgrades during the year.
 - 1. Scratch Coating
 - 2. Tint
 - 3. Polycarbonate Lenses, including UV
 - 4. Anti-reflective coating
- Member Perks Program Members can save on everyday items through two programs:
 - Abenity Discount Program Members can receive discounts on everyday items such as pizza, movie tickets, and oil changes. A comprehensive list of discounts and more information about the program can be found by visiting https://abenity.com/features/perks/ discounts
 - CVS Discount Program Allows members to receive a 20% savings on CVS healthy related items (fruit, vitamins, milk, etc.). Members will receive their CVS discount card in the mail and can shop at a CVS location or online.
- Over the Counter (OTC) Each head of household can order \$12 of OTC items each month without a script and mailed to your home. Plus, allowances can be rolled over for up to three (3) months at a time
- GED Benefit Members ages 16 and older who are not currently enrolled in school would receive the following:
 - Free GED testing.
 - Information and tools on test preparation.
 - Voucher to cover four (4) required tests.
- Hypoallergenic Bedding Qualified members receive hypoallergenic bedding to avoid asthma triggers.



- Baby Showers Provides pregnant members with gifts and tips for staying healthy; plus, a chance to win a prize.
- Free Cell Phone Program Two (2) programs for members to receive a cell phone.
 - Connections Plus* Provides a free cell phone to members with high-risk pregnancies engaged in a care management program who do not have a telephone. Cell phone would include unlimited text messaging and programmed numbers for the members' doctor, case manager, and social worker.
 - Safelink Get a free cell phone from Safelink/ TracFone, including 350 minutes for talk, 3GB of data, and unlimited texting.
- College Scholarships Scholarship award for members age 18 and up who are entering college. Space is limited.
- Girl Scouts Covers the annual membership fee for members and includes supply fee for badges and patches for members in grades K-12. Must have visited their PCP and dentist within the last 12 months. Does not include summer camps.
- Boys & Girls Club Provides membership for children ages 5-18. Must have visited their PCP and dentist within the last 12 months. Does not include summer camps.
- YMCA Family Membership Members ages 6 to 18 may receive a YMCA family membership. Must complete three (3) healthy activities or visit their PCP and dentist within the past 12 months.
- College Bound Dorm Room Supplies Members who will be heading to college and
 receive campus housing will be eligible for a
 dorm room supply kit providing needed items for
 a dorm room.

- Healthy Rewards Program Members can earn incentives for completing healthy behaviors. This program includes activities such as women's wellness exams and doctor visits.
- Sports Scholarship Organized youth team sports participants may earn a scholarship for uniforms and registration fees for basketball, football, cheerleading, or swimming lessons. Must have visited their PCP and dentist within the last 12 months.
- Free Gym Membership* Peach State Health
 Plan will cover the annual membership fee and
 the monthly fee at participating gyms for qualified
 members age 16 and older.
- Free Transportation All eligible Georgia Families
 Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids® members can
 receive free transportation to doctor and pharmacy
 visits.
- Start Smart For Your Baby Mom and baby can earn incentives on a reloadable Visa or MasterCard for healthy supplies such as vitamins, diapers, wipes, and fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Childcare Scholarship Assistance Members can receive up to \$125 annually to help pay childcare costs.
- SAT/ACT Guide Eligible Georgia Families Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids® members can receive free SAT or ACT study guide and practice exams.
- Quarterly Raffle Members ages 10-18 who complete a well visit during the previous quarter will be entered into a quarterly raffle to win gaming package or gift card/comparable item.

Eligible members may choose a maximum of two afterschool programs per calendar year between the following benefits: Girl Scouts, Boys & Girls Club, and YMCA Family Membership.
